To complete the online portion:

- 2) Pay for and complete this course, following the on-screen instructions. Be sure to print out the certificate at the end of the course.

We will choose the date and time that works best for us from that and a confirmation email will be sent to you.

4) Once you successfully pass the skills test, a course completion Ecard will be issued to you within hours after completing the Skill Check-off. The Ecard is sent directly to you from AHA. This card is valid for two years.
